## **Athletics**

### **Aavhan 2018**

The tournament is open to all Colleges, sports clubs, organisations and gymkhanas. This rulebook is binding and will be strictly followed in the course of the tournament.

#### **EVENTS:**

##### **Men**

Track: 100m , 200m, 400m, 800m, 1500m, 110m Hurdles, 4\*100m Relay and 4\*400m Relay  
Field: Long Jump, High Jump, Triple Jump, Pole Vault, Shot Put, Discus Throw, Javelin Throw and Hammer Throw

##### **Women**

Track: 100m , 200m, 400m, 800m and 4\*100m relay  
Field: Long Jump, High Jump, Shot Put and Discus Throw

#### **Registration Fee:**

Rs.100/- for individual events and Rs. 250/- for relay event

#### **PRIZE MONEY:**

##### Individual Events

1st Position - Rs. 500/-  
2nd Position - Rs. 300/-

##### Relay Events

1st Position - Rs. 800/-  
2nd Position - Rs. 500/-

\*Prize money will not be awarded in the events in which less than six athletes report at the starting point of the race. Only medal and certificates will be given in this case.

#### **SCHEDULE OF PLAY (Tentative):**

##### Day 1(31st March)

7:00 AM - 9:00 AM (Morning)  
3:00 PM - 5:00 PM (Evening)

##### Day 2(1st April)

7:00 AM - 9:00 AM (Morning)  
3:00 PM - 5:00 PM (Evening)

**Reporting Time:** Half hour before your event time

**Event Schedule:** To be decided

### **RULES OF PLAY:**

1. Each participant hereby certifies that the competitors who have been entered are bonafide members of the club/institution/gymkhana/organisation.
2. An athlete is allowed to participate in **maximum of 4 events** excluding relays
3. There is **no restriction** of number of participant from a college/sports club/gymkhana/organisation in a particular events
4. **Scoring** of points for the team championship and individual championship will be in the following manner

Position	Individual events	Relays
1	5	10
2	3	6
3	2	4
4	1	2

5. In case of a **tie** for an individual event, points will be shared by both athletes as shown in the following table. In case of relay events the points will be double as the relay events have double weightage. If the number of tied players are more than 4, 4 athletes will be chosen by lot and then points distributed accordingly.

6. The sum total of points secured in all the events by a team will determine their **overall position** in athletics. Winner trophy will be given to 1st position holder team

7. In case of **tie** for the overall position, whichever team has more gold medal/s will be given better position. If number of gold for both teams are same, then whichever team has more silver medal/s will be given better position. In case of same number of gold and silver medal/s, whichever team has more bronze medal/s will be given better position. In case of same number of gold, silver and bronze medal/s, whichever team has more 4th position will be given better position. In case of same number of gold, silver, bronze medal and 4th position, both team will be given same position
8. **Best athlete** for both Male and Female will be decided by the maximum number of points obtained by an athlete in individual events. In case of a tie for best athlete, the athlete who has broken the most number of meet records would be recognized. If the tie is still unresolved, award is given to the players having better team rank
9. **Minimum number** of athlete to start the event is three, otherwise the event will be cancelled and reported athletes will get refund
10. NO athlete will be allowed to compete without their bib number properly pinned on the chest and back.
11. He/she shall adhere to the rules of IIT Bombay and those laid down by the M.C.D.A.A.A and abide by the decision of officials and implicitly follow the instructions that may be given to them during the meet. The decision of the officials will be considered as final regarding the results.
12. Rights of Admission: Organizers reserve the right to admit or refuse any entry without assigning any reason thereof
13. Protest if any should be lodged with the concerned referee within 30 minutes of the finishing the event or announcement of the result along with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- The decision of the jury of appeal will be final and binding on both the participants and the organisers. Protest fee will be refunded if the protest is upheld
14. No outside video, photo or any kind of media footage will be accepted for the change in the result of events. Officials decision will be final.
15. The rules set by A.F.I will be applicable for all the events.
