General Rules And Regulations:

1. A list of 12 players should be given to the organizing team two days prior to the start of the tournament.
2. Flagrant fouls involving unsportsmanlike conduct will lead to player/team disqualification as per the officials' decision.
3. No valuables, accessories (other than sports non-apparel) will be allowed during gameplay.
4. All the games will be played as per FIBA rules and regulations.
5. In case of protest against the game result, the team captain must pay protest fee of INR 5000 and sign on the scoresheet to lodge a protest. The protest fee will be returned only if the protest is upheld by the organizing team.
6. In case of triple-tie in any league fixture, point differential for the entire pool will be taken into consideration. If two teams have the same point differential, the winner of their contest will be placed higher.
7. The whole team must report at the officials' table at least 20 minutes prior to each game.
8. If the teams fail to report even after 20 minutes of the scheduled time, the officials have the authority to give the opposite team a walkover over the late comer.

9. Rescheduling will be possible if the reason is genuine and if requested at least 24 hours prior to the game. Note that, rescheduling solely depends on the genuineness of the reason and the organizing team's discretion.
10. It's mandatory for every participant of every team to carry an institute ID card and a national ID card for verification.
11. Teams may have to play more than one match on single day.
12. If any team walks out of court during the playtime, that team will immediately be disqualified from tournament.
13. Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
14. Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly not prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.
15. Gum-soled shoes or non-marking basketball shoes are mandatory.
