Structure of the Championship

The final tournament will be in a league format, where 16 teams would be divided into pools of 4 each. Top two teams will qualify for the quarters, followed by semis and then finals.

Men's

Reg fees: ₹ 1,500

- Winner: ₹ 15,000
- Runner Up: ₹ 7,000

Women's

Reg fees: ₹ 1,000

- Winner: ₹ 7,000
- Runners Up: ₹ 4,000

Rules and regulations

- A list of 12 players should be given to the organizing team two days prior to the start of the tournament.
- Flagrant fouls involving unsportsmanlike conduct will lead to player/team disqualification as per the officials' decision
- No valuables, accessories (other than sports non-apparel) will be allowed during gameplay.
- It's mandatory for every participant of every team to carry an institute ID card and a national ID card for verification
- Teams are liable to disqualification against breach of disciplinary conduct if players/management are involved in illegal activities as per institute norms in IIT Bombay.
- Smoking/consumption of alcohol or any prohibited substances inside the campus are strictly not prohibited. Entire team will be disqualified from the tournament even if a single player is found to be violating these rules.
- All matches will be of 3 sets and all semi-finals and finals will be of 5 sets.
- If two or more faults are committed successively only the first one is considered.
- If faults are committed by both the teams simultaneously then the point becomes void i.e., it is a common point.
- Each team can request a maximum of 2 time-outs and 6 substitutions per set.
- There must be a completed rally between two separate substitution requests by the same team.

- Time-out requests must be made by showing the corresponding hand signal, when the ball is out of play and before the whistle for service.
- All requested time-outs last for 30 seconds.
- In case of any doubts, FIVB rules will be considered, though the referee's and organiser's decision shall be final and binding upon all candidates after which no further requests shall be entertained.

Rotation

- Rotation is compulsory in the game.
- Rotation faults will be penalized

Basic violations

- Stepping on or over the line on a serve.
- Failure to serve the ball over the net successfully.
- Hitting the ball illegally (Carrying, Palming, Throwing, etc.).
- Touches of the net with any part of the body while the ball is in play. If the ball is driven into the net with such force that it causes the net to contact an opposing player, no foul will be called, and the ball shall continue to be in play.
- Reaching over the net, except under these conditions:
 1. When executing a follow-through.
 2. When blocking a ball which is in the opponent's' court but is being returned (the blocker must not contact the ball until after the opponent who is attempting to return the ball makes contact). Except to block the third play.
- Reaches under the net (if it interferes with the ball or opposing player).
- Failure to serve in the correct order.

Dress code

T-shirt, gum soled shoes/Barefoot, shorts are must.

Note - Outdoor Shoes strictly prohibited inside indoor courts.

Walkover Rules

Organisers will have the power to give walkover to a team if the opposite team does not turn up in 15 minutes after the scheduled time. The power of giving walkover lies solely on the organisers.
